
#### The Naloxone Distribution Project


- The Naloxone Distribution Project (NDP) is funded by State General Funds, Opioid Settlement Funds, and federal grants and is administered by DHCS. The NDP aims to reduce opioid overdose deaths through the provision of free naloxone in its nasal spray and intramuscular formulations. Entities apply to DHCS to have naloxone shipped directly to their address.
- Eligible entities include law enforcement agencies such as police departments, county jails and probation; fire, EMS and first responders; schools and universities; county public health and behavioral health departments; harm reduction organizations; and community organizations such as local opioid coalitions.
- As of February 18, 2025, the NDP has:
  - Approved more than 14,300 applications for naloxone
  - Approved more than 5,832,100 kits of naloxone
  - Distributed more than 5,815,600 kits of naloxone
  - Reversed more than 337,000 opioid overdoses



#### Opioid Overdoses per 100,000 Residents, 2022




### **Approved Naloxone Kits per** 100,000 Residents, 2018-2025

#### NDP Applications by Type of Organization




#### Naloxone Kit Approved by Formulation

Naloxone Kits by Type of Organization




# Naloxone Kits by Law Enforcement & Criminal Justice Organizations


#### **Naloxone Kits by Community Organization**

## Naloxone Kits by Fire EMS & First Responders



### Reported Naloxone Reversals by Type of Organization



# Fentanyl Test Strip Applications by Type of Organization


